The Safety Committee met previously reviewing and making recommendations for the ESSER III Funds Budget. Mr. Bergman handed out and reviewed the proposed ESSER III Funds Budget. The hand out includes 2022-2023 projects and 2023-2024 projects.

Motion Blomberg, second Gierman to approve the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 ESSER III Funds Budget. Carried

A couple of meetings ago there was discussion regarding giving a personal day to all staff for all they have done during the Covid 19 period. The day could be used this year or carried over to next year. It would have to be used by the end of next school year.

Motion Gierman, second Hartmann to approve an All Staff Personal Day for Covid-19 Actions to be used by the end of the 2022-2023 school year. Carried
