Prospective Worker:

Under Wisconsin Child Labor Law IND #70, every employee under the age of 16 years must have a work permit. Presently, the only exceptions to this rule are babysitting, housework and farm work or if you are employed by your parents. In order to obtain a Work Permit the following are needed.

1. Birth, Baptismal Certificate or valid Wisconsin driver's license that contains a picture ID as evidence of age.
2. This form completed and signed by the employer and Guardian/Parent.
3. Your Social Security Card
4. Required fee of \$10.00

Please have the child bring these items to the School District of Prentice, Main Office during working hours. The Child must be present to sign the form when the work permit is processed.
