MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Adams at 6:03 PM.

Board members present: Adams, Gladson, Gruber, Isaacson, Palmquist and Pierson.  
Board members absent: Blomberg, Erickson and Gierman.

Reviewed the handed out 2022-2023 Revenue Limit Worksheet showing a Levy Rate of 0.00842241.

Reviewed line by line the handed out 2022-2023 Budget Revenue side. Last year the state kicked in \$70,000.00. As of now these dollars are not included in the budget because it is not known if the state will do it again.

Reviewed line by line the handed out 2022-2023 Budget Expense side. The budget is higher than last year in part due to anticipated wage increases to be around \$160,000.00. Some of the ESSER dollars in last years budget will not be available either. At the present time will be taking out \$151,551.00 out of Fund Balance to balance the 2022-2023 budget.

Motion Isaacson, second Gruber to approve the 2022-2023 Budget as presented. Carried

Motion Palmquist, second Gladson to approve the Levy Rate of 0.00842241. Carried

Discussion occurred regarding having the Baird Company do a Financial Outlook for the district. Have worked with Kevin before who is now with Baird, they also have a person who specializes in school finances. If approved Mr. Bergman would have them come in this fall. Estimated cost for the evaluation would be between \$4,000.00-\$6,000.00. If a referendum would be run there would be public informational meetings held. A Baird Company representative would be present at those meetings.

Motion Gruber, second Gladson to approve Baird for a Financial Outlook for the District. Carried

Motion Gladson, second Palmquist to adjourn. Carried
