The Principals Report was given by Mr. Bergman:

-Mr. Bergman wrote and received a grant for welders.

-Mr. Bergman wrote and received a grant for a salad bar.

-TDS is here putting in new servers.

-After the Texas School shooting law enforcement was here to talk. Suggestions to have doors wired so know when they are left open. May have to go to a single entry. It has been both staff and students leaving doors open. Probably have all entries go thru the office. Mental health issues were brought up also. Mr. Bergman will get an estimate on what having monitors put on doors would cost.

-Mr. Bergman said in the future a referendum will have to be run. He has been working with Baird now on finances.

Board member Erickson arrived at 7:40 PM.

-Teaching positions are very difficult to fill. Home Economics is the only vacant position.

-Summer School has 80-90 students every day eating breakfast and lunch.

-All went well for the end of school.

Five students want to do classes thru the Start College Now and Early College Credit Program.

Motion Gierman, second Blomberg to approve the Start College Now and Early College Credit Program for five students. Carried

Discussed and reviewed the AGR spread sheet end of Spring Semester 2022 that was handed out. A lot of improvements were shown. Speech is one of the big issues with some of the younger students coming in.

Discussed and reviewed the ESSA Plan for Federal Grants. A brief breakdown is Title I is reading K-4. Title II is for Teachers teaching Teachers, chrome books, laptops and other technology materials. It can also be used to help some Teachers with licensing. Title IV is a general area as long as it goes for kids benefits.

Motion Blomberg, second Gierman to hire Pam Kevilus as Head Cook. Carried

Motion Gruber, second Palmquist to hire Derek Rohde as Assistant Football Coach. Carried

Reviewed the Co-Curricular Code 2022 focusing on the violation requirements. Motion Blomberg, second Gladson to approve the Co-Curricular Code 2022 with the changes high lighted in yellow. Carried

Motion Erickson, second Palmquist to renew the Rural WiRSA Membership. Carried

Motion Palmquist, second Gierman to renew membership in the WASB. Carried

The 2021-2022 Budget is being finalized. Mr. Bergman won't carry any remaining dollars to Fund Balance because the state views this as though the district doesn't need the money. May be used to pay down debt on busses.

Handed out was the 2022-2023 Revenue Limit Worksheet. The sheet was reviewed line by line. The base revenue will be down.

Motion Erickson, second Gladson to assign any remaining 2021-2022 remaining funds to Fund-Balance Assigned. Carried

Discussed and reviewed the Annual Meeting Notice and Agenda. The Annual Meeting will be held on Monday, July 25, 2022. Each meal fee will be raised by \$.20. This number is set by DPI. The \$50.00 Fee for School Activities will no longer have any refund at the end of the year.

Motion Gierman, second Blomberg to approve the 2022 Annual School District Meeting School District of Prentice as stated Deleting Item # 5, Board Clerk Reads Auditors Report. Item # 7 deleting \$10.00 is refunded at the end of each school year if all the textbooks are returned, lockers are undamaged and bills are paid. Carried

A Special Meeting date has been set for June 30th at 5:00 PM.

Motion Blomberg, second Gladson to adjourn. Carried
